General Information

The first day

School begins on Tuesday 2 February at 8.35am.

Present students will go to the gym and we will welcome new students and teachers from there. Seniors (year 11-12-13) need to be in formal uniform.

New teachers and students will meet in the carpark with their parents (if you can come), and you will be led to the gym to be welcomed in a powhiri.

Then we will have morning tea and the first class. Parents are welcome to stay for this part of the day if you can.

Stationery

We pride ourselves in making a good start to the year. We can't afford to waste time getting started on our year's teaching programme. So we ask that on the first day every student brings their money for stationery.

The order forms will be sent out in the December 2009

mailout. You will see that we are asking you to get some of the stationery yourself – there are plenty of really good specials in late January. If you want to set up an automatic payment in advance, please contact Business Manager Ron Van Drunen before school begins.

Partnership with parents

At Garin we see ourselves as working alongside parents to help you raise your young people to be the adults you want them to become.

We make contact with parents in a formal way each term:

- In term 1 we have a barbecue for all, a phone call home for parents of new students, and our "attitude" reports for all students.
- In term 2 we have senior interviews and reports for all students.
- In term 3 we have junior interviews and an NCEA update for senior students.
- In term 4 senior reports will be issued after exams, and juniors at the end of the year.
- In the middle of Terms 1, 2 and 3, we send home milestone reports on students whose work has slipped.

Of course, whenever you have information to share with us – or concerns – about the educational or personal development of your son or daughter, please don't hesitate to talk to us.

Who to talk to

Your first port of call to talk about your own child or problems he or she might be having is your whanau teacher.

In the office (543 9488) you will talk to Leonie Haines, Rachel Bright or Shona Erasmuson. Our DP and Club Garin contact is Denis Moriarty; and Mike Rose looks after Student Services, behavioural and learning difficulties, as well as course selection. Our Gateway Co-ordinator Jane Krammer, is the person to see to discuss careers.

If a student is ill: ring the "Absence line"

The very best way to report a student's absence from school is to leave a message on our voicemail – just call 543 9490 and leave a message.

If a student becomes ill during the day we will normally let them stay in the sick bay for half an hour – but if they haven't recovered we will call you to collect them.

One other thing to note is that we do not administer medication (even *Panadol*). Our staff are not trained to take responsibility for that, so we don't have medication available.

Lunch at school

2010 sees a continuation of our Healthy Food initiative (the first school in Nelson to gain a Gold award), and we encourage students to join in: it helps learning and gives us longer and happier lives! We appreciate parent support with "learning friendly" lunches.

Our own canteen serves a wide range of good food, and provides a hot water urn and a microwave for student use.

The new timetable

In 2010, we are moving to a new structure for the Garin day to allow staff to have the breaks allowed for in legislation, to allow a new subject to be introduced in the junior school, and to allow longer whanau classes and better careers education. You will see the details in the calendar, but the major changes are a rolling assembly that will equalise time lost from subjects, allow a longer whanau/careers slot each week and there will be two 40 minute breaks during the day for meetings and lunch (so students are able to eat more regularly and maintain their focus for the whole school day).

Rolling Assemblies

As you will see in the calendar, Assemblies are on different days this year. This means that the same subject is not badly affected over the course of the year. The day will begin at 8.35am with Assembly. By 9.05am students will be in whanau classes for half an hour to give them a worthwhile opportunity to develop relationships, investigate careers and follow-up on the needs of students.

Daily times

School begins at 8.35 each day – so students need to be here at 8.30 to get organised and ready to start at 8.35. Our timetable runs like this:

Study Hall

Our teachers are trained to manage the behaviour of our students – and we have systems for the times our students refuse to meet our expectations. Of course, a teacher cannot use their training or our systems if the student is not in class on time – or comes without the equipment needed to allow them to learn.

When that happens a student receives a "Study Hall", a catch-up session. Students must bring work, and use the time to catch up on work missed. Study halls are held every lunchtime. If students default on study halls, they will be given a prosocial class on a Wednesday after school where they will research a particular topic tailored to the issue that they are trying to address.

Peer Tutoring

This is a new complimentary tutoring programme to the many and varied tutoring systems already existing and being offered by staff and faculties. Individual students can be teamed up with an expert senior student tutor to accelerate their learning. A small cost will be involved.
