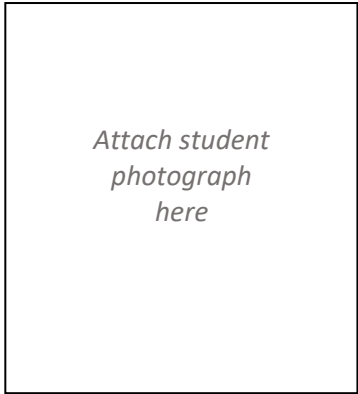

Scholarship Criteria

- New or existing students to Garin College.
- Applicants must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
- Scholarship holders will be expected to participate in the wider life of Garin College including sports, arts and service and to represent Garin College at events and competitions.
- Scholarships are reviewed by the School Principal mid-year and at the end of each year with cancellation of a scholarship possible if the agreed goals for the year have not been met.

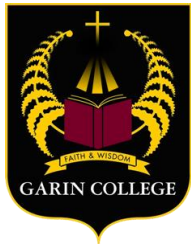
