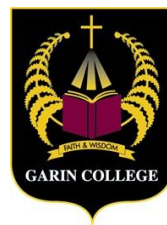


Garin College Uniform



Years 9 and 10 - Summer (1 Sept to end of Term 1)

Compulsory

- White blouse with Garin logo or Garin blue polo shirt (short or long sleeves)
- Garin skirt, lavalava or clerical grey shorts with Garin logo or clerical grey long trousers with Garin logo
- Plain black polishable shoes (below the ankle) with plain black socks or Garin socks with blue stripes **OR**
- Plain black or dark brown sandals without socks

For additional warmth

- Blue Garin jersey with logo

Years 9 and 10 - Winter (start of Term 2 to 1 Sept)

Compulsory

- White blouse with Garin logo or Garin blue polo shirt (short or long sleeves)
- Garin skirt, lavalava or clerical grey shorts with Garin logo or clerical grey long trousers with Garin logo
- Plain black polishable shoes below the ankle
- Plain black socks or tights or Garin socks with blue stripes

For additional warmth

- Blue Garin jersey with logo
- Garin scarf

OPTIONAL EXTRA for winter

Garin jacket with logo or plain black puffer jacket may be worn OVER but not INSTEAD OF the blue jersey. This is for additional warmth when travelling to and from school or at break times. Jackets must not be worn in class.

Years 11, 12 and 13 - Summer (1 Sept to end of Term 1)

Compulsory

- White Garin blouse with logo (long or short sleeved) or white Garin shirt with logo (long or short sleeved)
- Garin skirt, shorts, lavalava or long clerical grey trousers with Garin logo
- Black polishable shoes (below the ankle) with plain black socks **OR**
- Plain black or dark brown sandals without socks

For additional warmth

- Black Garin jersey or black Garin vest with logo

FORMAL OCCASIONS - Black Garin Blazer, Garin tie, Garin skirt or long clerical grey trousers with Garin logo, black polishable shoes and black socks

Years 11, 12 and 13 - Winter (start of Term 2 to 1 Sept)

Compulsory

- White Garin blouse with logo (long or short sleeved) or white Garin shirt with logo (long or short sleeved)
- Garin skirt, lavalava or long clerical grey trousers with Garin logo
- Black Garin blazer - must be worn (can be taken off in class or if warm at break times. The blazer must be with the student at all times and worn into class.)
- Garin tie - must be worn at all times
- Plain black polishable shoes below the ankle
- Plain black socks or tights

For additional warmth

- Black jersey or black vest with Garin logo
- Garin scarf

OPTIONAL EXTRA for winter

Garin jacket with logo or plain black puffer jacket may be worn OVER but not INSTEAD OF the blazer/jersey/vest. This is for additional warmth when travelling to and from school or at break times. Jackets must not be worn in class.

Jewellery - all year levels

- Taonga
